TOURNAMENT RULES

The tournament is sanctioned by the B.T.B.A. and the general playing and tournament rules will govern this event together with the following special rules:

1. All entrants must have been born in Bedfordshire, been resident in the County for a period of one or more years and not have bowled for any other County for at least one year unless they have deregistered in accordance with the Inter County Rules. If a bowler lives and was born in a county that has no local association then if they bowl in league in another area they can declare to the IC secretary that they wish to participate for that county. If either their county of residence or birth form an accepted county association this temporary attachment will be rescinded
2. HM Forces must have been resident for a period of 6 months.
3. All entrants must hold a current BTBA card which must be produced at the Trials If you are unable to do they may bowl "at the Tournament Managers discretion". If a bowler is then found to NOT be a member then their scores would be removed.
4. Any juniors who participate must hold an Adult BTBA card to participate in U25 and adult categories..
5. All entrants must abide by Inter-County Tournament rules available to see on the BTBA website
6. The top 15 Men and top 15 Ladies will be registered players for Bedfordshire during the 2018/19 season
7. Players wishing to bowl in the Seniors must be 50 years of age on or by the 1st June 2018
8. The decision of the Tournament Manager is final in respect of any dispute with appeal to the BTBA
9. Any computer alterations must be made in the presence of a Tournament Official. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in said score being forfeit.
10. No denims, vests or shorts (except tailored shorts) will be permitted.
11. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. Protests must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Manager within 72 hours of the game in which the infraction occurred.
12. To be eligible for selection, individuals must participate in the selection tournament. At

the discretion of the county and the appropriate Team England Managers, England squad members may be exempt and seeded into their eligible age group and no roll off will be required.

13. Withdrawal from the trials through injury or illness will result in the total pinfall bowled being valid for submission to the relevant Inter-County Secretary of the BTBA.

FORMAT

Registration for each squad will start at 30 minutes before the roll off times. There will be no "grace" frames and no catching up

The format for the trial will be bowled over 6 games, moving lanes after each game and will be played at doubles or trios pace, depending on entries, but all dates will as consistent as possible.

SELECTION

Selection for the County teams to play in the qualifying rounds of either the Adult and/or Senior divisions, will be based on the trial results plus any practice sessions and challenge matches, arranged by the Team Managers.

Participation in the 2018 championships is dependent on the numbers of bowlers trying out for the teams. If we fail to field a full team, the association will arrange opportunities to represent the county in other ways
