

GENERAL FORMAT

Entries are invited for the Oxfordshire County Trials 2018 to select the Mens and Ladies County Squads in the Adult and Senior divisions. The top 2 qualifiers in each group will be invited to play at least two games in the qualifying round. The rest of the **squad** will be made up from the next 13 highest scratch scores bowled in each division. Each entrant will bowl 6 games, changing lanes every three games. Lanes will be dressed prior to bowling but there will be no re-oil. Note, all bowlers **MUST** provide a current BTBA card at time of registration or register on day at standard BTBA subscription rates. **All bowlers will be automatically entered into the adult division unless they specifically note otherwise below.**

Each entrant must supply their **FULL** name, nationality, address, DOB and the details of the car they will be travelling in to attend the event at RAF Brize Norton. Failure to divulge all details on the entry form will result in the entry being rejected & access to the base will be refused. Also the document number used for identity purposes **MUST** be supplied.

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY SQUADS

To be eligible to trial for the Oxfordshire Squads you must satisfy the following criteria:-

1. Be a current member in good standing of the BTBA or affiliated association.
2. Be eligible to hold a British passport, or have lived continuously in the UK for at least five years.
3. Have been born within the boundaries of Oxfordshire (as established in 1961)
Or
Have resided within the boundaries of Oxfordshire, (as established in 1961), for not less than one year as of 1st January 2018. Serving members of H.M. Forces and their dependents shall qualify after six months residential period prior to same date.
4. Seniors must be 50 years of age on or before 1st May 2018.
There are no age restrictions for the Adult Squad.

The entry fee for all squad trials is **£20.00** per entrant. This fee **must** accompany the entry form and includes lineage of £15.00, £2.00 towards the Team England International Fund, 10p for expenses and £2.90p to OLTBA. Cheques must be made payable to **OLTBA**.

All bowlers must register by 9:45am. Bowling will commence at 10:00am.

**The closing date for entries is 12 noon on 26 March 2018
NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED PAST THIS DEADLINE.**

1. The Tournament is sanctioned by the BTBA and the general playing and tournament rules will govern this event together with the following special rules.
2. This tournament is only open to current members of the BTBA on production of a current membership card.
3. Any person who bowls under an assumed name, bowls under the name of a scheduled entrant who fails to attend, or is under suspension, shall forfeit their entry and any and all rights to claim or hold any trophy in said tournament. Such persons are subject to suspension.
4. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately.
5. Protests must be made to the Tournament Manager within 30 minutes of the alleged infraction occurring & confirmed in writing within 72 hours. The Tournament manager's decision shall be final, subject to an appeal to the BTBA
6. The tournament manager reserves the right to reject any entry and his/her decision on all matters shall be final, subject to an appeal to the BTBA.
7. Participants must be dressed neatly & wear clothing suitable for public appearances. Denim clothing **will not be** permitted. Entrants who, in the judgement of the Tournament Manager, do not meet these requirements will not be permitted to bowl
8. Smoking or vaping is not permitted within the centre, eating & drinking is forbidden within the playing area. **No participant may consume alcohol during play** and any participant deemed to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs may be excluded from further participation at the discretion of the Tournament Manager. Smoking areas are provided outside the bowling centre. Bowlers are not allowed to venture away from the centre for any reason.
