**Format**

**6 Games 5 Person mixed teams.**

Teams can be made up of any bowler registered to the same association, Juniors are welcome but must hold an adult membership. Seniors, Juniors and Ladies will receive 10 pins bonus per game, bonus pins will only be applied once.

Each team will earn bonus pins at the end of each game. The highest score in each game will earn 160 bonus pins, 2<sup>nd</sup> 150 pins, 3<sup>rd</sup> 140 pins etc.

The winners will be decided based on total scratch pinfall plus bonus pins.

**Rules**

General playing rules of the BTBA will be followed along with the following additions:

All disputes must be raised immediately with the tournament managers. When a dispute cannot be resolved, the frame shall be replayed.

Alcohol cannot be consumed during play, Food and Drink must be kept outside the players area. The players area is defined as the area stepped down to from the carpeted area. Alcohol can be consumed during the lunch break.

Slow play will not be tolerated, if deliberate slow play is suspected the tournament manager will issue 1 warning, if this continues after the 1<sup>st</sup> warning the player will be disqualified.

Any late bowlers will begin play at the frame in progress, if they arrive before the 5<sup>th</sup> Frame they will be able to catch up the frames, if arrival after 5<sup>th</sup> frame the frames missed will scored as 0.

**Dress code** – Team Shirts to be worn bearing name of the local association. Jeans, Shorts, Skorts, Jogging bottoms, Leggings and Trousers are allowed.

**Fundraising Opportunities**

In addition to bowling there will also be a raffle and bake sale.

**Bake Sale**

County Associations are invited to bring their own items to sell to raise money for their county.

**Raffle**

County Associations are invited to bring items for the raffle, any association attending will be able to sell their own tickets in advance of the event. They will keep any ticket sales they have raised.
