Tournament Rules

1. This is a JTE/YTE/BTBA Tour Event. The General Playing and Tournament Rules of the B.T.B.A together with the following special rules shall govern this tournament.
2. The tournament is open to all members of the B.T.B.A. in possession of a new style membership card. The tournament manager will verify membership via the database before the event.
3. All bowlers must be under the age of 22 years as at August 31st 2019
4. There will be four divisions:

Division 1:	Combined Average	360 and above
Division 2	Combined Average	between 305 and 359
Division 3:	Combined Average	between 240 -304
Division 4	Combined Average	under 239

5. Format will be doubles throughout. All bowlers will bowl eight games moving lanes after every two games.
6. Squads will be mixed classifications in order that Y.B.C's can travel and bowl together. Lane draw will be random and made by the Centres main computer system.
7. The tournament is a scratch tournament. Prizes are based on an entry of 100 Teams and will be adjusted accordingly. Prizes will be awarded for the first three places in each division provided there are at least eight teams in the division. Re-entries are not permitted. Included is a £100 perfect 300 fund which if not used will be used as encouragement awards There is also Bowling equipment to the value of £50 for High Game, Boys and Girls
8. Entries will be squadded on a first come first served basis, **however Bowlers from local centres will be expected to bowl in the early squads. Preference will be given to YBC's travelling in excess of 100 miles.**
The overflow will only be used if all other squads are completely full.
9. Registration will be 30 minutes prior to bowling. If all bowlers are present and registered then the Tournament Managers have the right to start the squad early. Tardy players will commence play at the frame in progress as directed by the Tournament Managers.

11. Fees must accompany the entry form and be returned by Friday 8th September 2018 Cheques should be made payable to 'Bowplex Poole Youth Bowling Club -AC Tournament'. It is the responsibility of the Y.B.C. official to ensure that their entries have been received. Refunds will not be made once entry has been accepted & squadded.
12. Any changes to pairings must be notified to the Squadding Manager no less than 5 (five) clear days before the date of bowling. Only like for like changes will be permitted after that period.
13. Shirts must bear the name of a Y.B.C. or the player's name. Sponsors details may be included except for alcohol or tobacco products. Casual shorts, tracksuit bottoms, cargo trousers, denim clothing or jeans of any description will not be permitted, however, skorts, and tailored short trousers are allowed. Mobile phones must be turned off during match play and are not permitted in the playing area. No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcoholic beverages anywhere in the centre during the tournament. Any breach of this rule will result in immediate disqualification from the tournament. Profane language, improper gestures or abuse of the bowling equipment or machinery may also result in disqualification. Any disqualification will result in the loss of scores and awards. Any player whose conduct is likely to bring the sport into disrepute will be disqualified from the tournament and reported to the B.T.B.A. for consideration of disciplinary proceedings.
14. Bowlers are expected to keep up with the pace of play. Any bowler not ready to bowl at the earliest opportunity will score zero for the frame in play.
15. Only Tournament Officials, Competitors and one licensed Instructor/Coach will be allowed in the player's area during the game. For details of Coaching/Instructing see BTBA rule 333. Coaches and Instructors are required to display their license at all times and also to be dressed in accordance with their position.
16. Please be aware before, during, and after the event there could be filming, action photography or video taken of participants and medal winners by anyone attending the event, either as an official, spectator, parent or guardian. If you (as a participant, parent or guardian) object to this, you must your objections known to the tournament manager prior to the event starting and reasonable adjustments will be made.
17. The Tournament Managers are Carol Ailes and Mike Jenkins. The Tournament Managers reserve the right to re-rate or reject any entry. A provisional ball shall be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. Protests should be made to the Tournament Manager within 30 minutes of the end of the game in question and confirmed in writing before the end of the tournament. The Squadding Manager is Ian Ailes
18. The Welfare Officer responsible for the Event is Mike Jenkins.
19. The Tournament Manager's decision is final, subject to appeal to the B.T.B.A
20. Please could all entrants bring a raffle prize to help raise funds for Poole YBC.
