- 1) The Tournament will constitute the Shropshire County Trials for the for the 2018/19 Men's and Ladies squads in the Adult, Seniors (50+) and u22's categories
- 2) The Tournament shall be sanctioned by the B.T.B.A. as tournament number 19/0015 and shall be open to current members of the B.T.B.A. only. BTBA memberships will be checked for validity on the BTBA member listing which can be viewed at btba.org.uk.
- 3) The Tournament will be bowled at AMF Shrewsbury, Brixton Way, Shrewsbury, Shropshire SY1 3AZ (0844 826 3032) on Sunday 24th February 2019 with an overflow if required on Thursday 21st February 2019. Registration will open 45 minutes before the first squad, and will close 15 minutes before the squad starts.
- 4) Eligibility for selection into a Shropshire County Team is dependent upon a bowler satisfying one of the following criteria;
 - Must have been born within the County of Shropshire (1961 boundary)
 - Must have been resident within the County of Shropshire (1961 boundary) for no less than 1 year (6 months for military personnel)
 - Qualification as an 'Orphan Bowler' (resides or was born in a county with no Local Association but participates in a league in Shropshire)
- 5) i) The Tournament will be played under the general playing rules and regulations of the B.T.B.A.
 - ii) Late arrivals will only be allowed to compete at the Tournament Director's discretion, and must commence bowling at the frame in progress for their allocated squad, all previous frames being scored at zero.
- 6) The Tournament Director will be Pete Spearing, whose decision on the day will be final, subject to appeal to the B.T.B.A.
- 7) The Tournament Treasurer reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry. Late entries are also accepted only at the Tournament Treasurer's discretion. The Tournament Treasurer will be Paul Williams
- 8) The entry fee will be £25 per person. For each competitor, this includes a donation of £2 towards the Tournament Sanction Fund & £5 Shropshire Contribution. Part A to be issued to:
