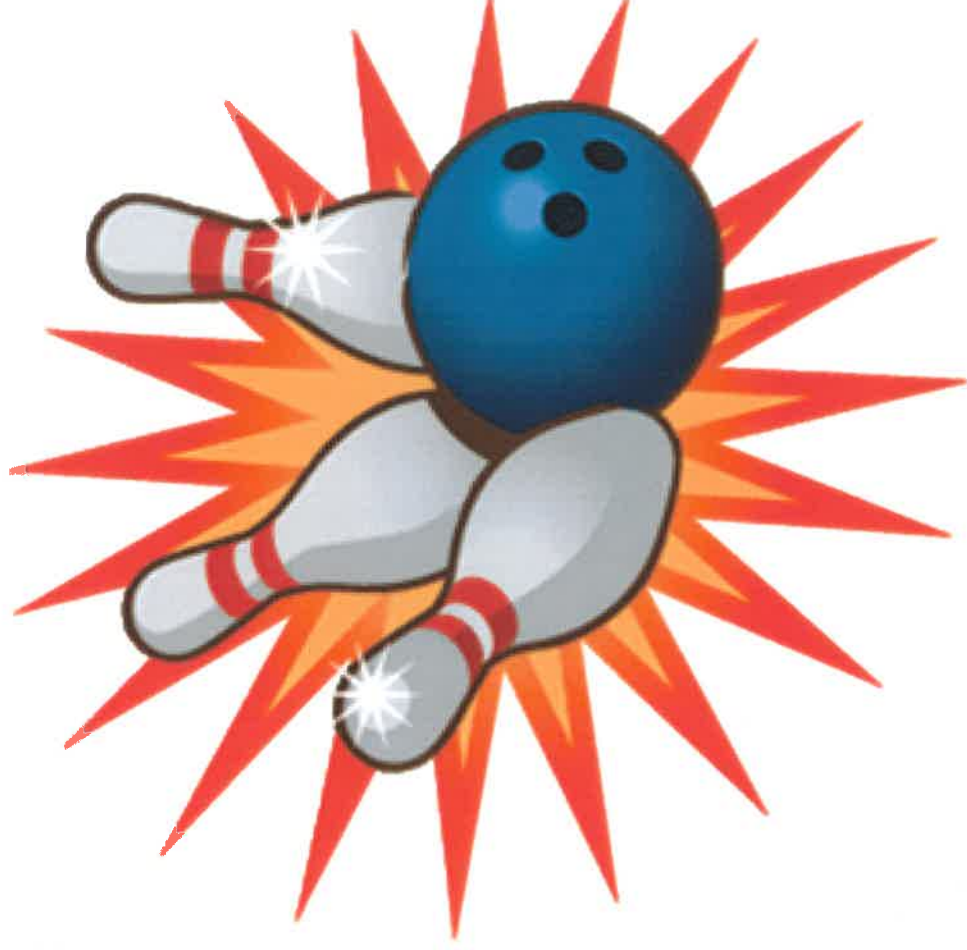

**RULES**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Born in the county or resident in the county for more than one year, eligible to hold a British Passport and a BTBA member of good standing. All entrants who are selected to play for their County Team will be required to sign, and adhere to, the BTBA Code of Conduct. Copy to be displayed on Tournament Notice Board.

**AGE DIVISIONS:** Male and Female  
Under 16 year: Bowlers born in 2003 or later  
Under 12 year: Bowlers born in 2007 or later

**FORMAT:** The tournament will be over 6 single games, changing lanes every 2 games. Overall scratch pin fall to establish the placing in each division.  
The top two bowlers from each division will be invited to bowl at least 2 games in the qualifying rounds of the Inter-Counties Championship.

Top 10 in each division, male and female, to qualify for selection purposes.

**REGISTRATION:** Closing date for entries is March 3rd 2019. All bowlers must register at least 30 minutes before the start time. BTBA Membership will be checked on the BTBA Database. Non membership will result in a fine equal to the cost of the Direct Membership - currently £15.00 Junior.

**PLAYING RULES:** This Tournament is sanctioned by the BTBA. General playing rules and Tournament rules of the BTBA together with the following special rules shall govern the event.

Dress - Competitors, who, in the opinion of the tournament manager, are not correctly attired, will not be permitted to bowl. Shirts must bear the name of the players YBC or the player's name. Casual shorts, jeans or denim clothing of any description will not be permitted, however skorts, culottes and tailored short trousers may be allowed.

Only Competitors and licensed YBC Officials or Instructors will be allowed in the playing area and must observe the dress code and display their License.

No competitor may use improper gestures, profane language or abuse of bowling equipment or machinery. Any breach of this rule will result in immediate disqualification of the individual from the tournament. Disqualification may result in loss of scores and awards.

**PROTESTS:** A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. Protests must be lodged verbally to the Tournament Manager within 30 minutes of the completion of the game and in writing within 72 hours of the game. The Tournament Managers decision shall be final subject to an appeal to the BTBA.

**PHOTOGRAPHS:** Before, during and after the event there could be photography, filming or video taken of participants by anyone attending the event, either as an official, spectator, parent or guardian. If you (as the participant, parent or guardian) object to this, you must make your objections known to the tournament manager prior to the event starting and reasonable adjustments will be made.
