TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This Tournament will be sanctioned by the BTBA and conforms to the general playing and tournament rules of the BTBA together with the following additions.

2. The Tournament is open to all current members of the BTBA. BTBA memberships will be checked for validity on the BTBA members list which can be viewed at btba.org.uk. Non-members may participate on payment of £22.50, the cost of normal annual membership.

3. To qualify the individual must have been born within the boundaries of Buckinghamshire or have resided in Bucks for not less than one year. Serving member of HM Forces and their dependants shall qualify after six months residential period.

4. To be eligible for selection, individuals must participate in the Bucks County Roll-off tournament.

5. The trials will be for Men, Ladies **and Seniors** scratch basis. Please Note, at the County Association think tank in November 2018 it was voted on that age bonus pins would be removed for the County Championship.

6. A provisional ball will be rolled if a dispute relating to pin fall cannot be resolved immediately. All protests must be made verbally to the Tournament Manager (Andy Giles) within 30 minutes of the infringement taking place and confirmed in writing to the same within 72 hours of the game in which the infraction occurred. The decision of the tournament manager, on all matters, shall be final, subject to appeal to the BTBA.

7. Age qualification for Seniors is 50 by 31st December 2019.

8. No competitor is allowed to consume ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES until they have completed play on the day. There is NO SMOKING within the centre.

9. All players will wear suitable bowling attire. The wearing of denim or shorts will not be permitted.

10. Any player whose conduct is considered liable to bring the game into disrepute will be disqualified from the tournament. Any individual so disqualified will be reported to the BTBA for consideration of disciplinary proceedings.

11. The use of abrasives on bowling balls is prohibited during a game. However, the rule has changed to allow surface changes between games.

12. The top 2 in all sections / divisions will be given the opportunity to play a minimum of two games in the qualifying rounds.

13. The top 15 bowlers from the County roll-offs will be registered for the County team and should make themselves available for all rounds of the County tournaments plus any practice sessions arranged by the County. There will also challenge matches available in the run up to qualifying rounds.

Eligible bowlers that wish to enter both the Adults and Seniors will be charged an additional £10.00 to cover the Bucks County fee.

15. Squad times will be as follows;

Sunday 10th March 2019 – registration at 5.30pm – Roll-off at 6pm

Wednesday 13th March 2019 – registration at 6pm – Roll-off at 6:30pm

Please note that the Bucks County AGM will take place at 5pm on Sunday 10th March.

16. The closing date for entries will be 5.30pm on Sunday 10th March 2019 (first come first served to the maximum number of entries for each squad – subject to lane availability)

17. Men - The format will be 6 games, changing lanes after every 2 games. It is *anticipated* that there will be a max of five bowlers to a pair of lanes (dependant on numbers).

Ladies – The format will be 4 games – changing lanes after two.

18. The tournament will be run by the Bucks Area Association Committee. Entry forms should be sent, with the entry fee, for the attention of

Please note –

- *The Senior County Qualifying Round will be held on the weekend of either 1st or 2nd June 2019 at a location to be confirmed depending on which group we are placed (which will be drawn at the BTBA Nationals during March). The top three male and top two female teams from each day and each group will qualify for the finals. The Finals will be held on the weekend of 12th & 13th Oct' 2019.*
- *The Adult County Qualifying Round will be held on the 8th Sept' 2019 at a venue in the Central Region of the BTBA. The top four male and female teams from each region will qualify for the finals. The Finals will be held on the weekend of 2nd & 3rd Nov' 2019 at TBC.*
