## RULES

- 1 The Kent County Trials will be sanctioned by the BTBA and their general rules will apply.
- 2 Each participant must be eligible to hold a British passport, or if not, a British National who has been in permanent residence in the UK for at least five years.
- 3 Each participant must have been born within the county boundaries of Kent or must have been resident in the county of Kent for a period of at least one year.
- 4 Any participant who has previously bowled for another county must apply for de-registration with the County Secretary and have been de-registered for one year before they can be considered for the Kent County Team. If an individual fails to notify the County Secretary they will become eligible to bowl for Kent after a period of one year provided that they have not been re-registered to bowl with another county during that time and have resided in Kent for a minimum of one year.
- 5 Seniors must be aged 50 years-of-age on or before the 31st December in the year of the championship, and must enter their date of birth on the entry form.
- 6 The 2019 Kent Trials will be run over 6 games scratch, changing lanes after every two games. The top 15 bowlers from each division will be registered with for Kent County for 2019. No bowler can be selected for any squad unless they have participated in the appropriate trial event.
- 7 The top two qualifiers in each division are guaranteed to play at least two games in the qualifying round, in accordance with the BTBA Inter County rules. The teams will be selected by invitation.
- 8 When protests involving a foul or the legality of pinfall is entered and cannot immediately be resolved then a provisional ball or frame should be bowled.
- 9 Entry fee for Adults and Seniors will be £39.00 for one event, inclusive of a £2.00 tournament sanction fee. An additional fee of £8.00 must be paid for any extra events. No refunds will be made after acceptance, and full entry fees must accompany the application.
- 10 Registration will be 15 minutes prior to squad time. All competitors should be registered with the BTBA. BTBA memberships will be checked for validity on the members list at [btba.org.uk](http://btba.org.uk). **Please note that the closing date for entries will be Monday 25th February, 2019, and will be strictly adhered to.**
- 11 The Kent county organiser's decision upon matters will be final subject to an individual's right to appeal to the BTBA. In this respect any protest must be made verbally at the time of occurrence and confirmed in writing within 72 hours.
- 12 Latecomers will begin to play at the frame then being bowled on the allocated lane. No score can be given for the frames that were missed.
- 13 Competitors will not be allowed to smoke (this includes electronic cigarettes) or consume alcoholic beverages in the centre during tournament play. Bad language, abuse of bowling equipment or machinery, or bringing the game into disrepute may result in disqualification by the tournament manager. Before, during, and after the event there could be photography, filming or video taken of participants and medal winners by anyone attending the event, either as an official, spectator, parent or guardian. If you (as a participant, parent or guardian) object to this, you must make your objections known to the tournament manager prior to the event starting and reasonable adjustments will be made.
- 14 Competitors who, in the opinion of the tournament manager, are not dressed in a presentable manner will not be permitted to bowl. Shorts, denim clothing of any description, hats, torn trousers are considered to be unacceptable and may not be worn. **Mobile phones must be switched off in the playing area during play.**
