Rules

- 1 This Tournament will be sanctioned and played under the general rules of the BTBA.
 BTBA memberships will be checked for validity on the BTBA members list which can be viewed at btba.org.uk. Those whose membership have expired will be levied a £2 fine. Non-Members will not be eligible for B.T.B.A services.
- 2 Each team will bowl 42 games in total. 3 doubles, 2 trios, 6 Baker Games
 Every Player is to drop for a Baker game allowing a team average handicap
- 3 The overall winners will be the team recording the highest pinfall including handicap.
- 4 Entries will be limited to 28 teams. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis
 Emailed or phone entries will only be accepted if payment is accepted within 7 days of the application.
- 5 Handicaps will be based on 80% of the difference between the bowlers entering average and 225. The bowlers average will be taken from previous years of the tournament, if you have not bowled before you must declare your highest league average or Tournament average over 18 games as at the tournament closing date. Where a bowler has no average over 18 games he or she may use their latest completed average (subject to the 5 pin drop rule). Any player with no known average will enter off scratch. Falsification of averages will result in disqualification.
- 6 Closing date for entries is midnight on 19th July 2019. The tournament manager reserves the right to cancel the tournament should there be less than 16 teams entered by this date. All entries must be accompanied by a £150 deposit. Deposits will not be refunded (apart from cancellation).
- 7 The tournament manager, James Hunt, reserves the right to reject any entry, or rerate any average. A provisional ball will be permitted where a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved. Protests in connection with the tournament must be notified to the Tournament Manager within 30 minutes of the end of the series giving rise to the protest being confirmed with-in 24 hours. Any decision rendered by the tournament manager will be final, subject to appeal to the BTBA.
- 8 Bowlers are not permitted to bring their own food and drink into the bowling centre for consumption.
