TOURNAMENT RULES

- This tournament is sanctioned by the BTBA and the General playing and tournament rules will govern this event, together with the following special rules.
- The tournament is open to current members of the BTBA.
Non-members may enter, on payment of a £2 surcharge, but will not be eligible for BTBA Services.
 Proof of membership will be checked against the BTBA Members List prior to participation.
Only BTBA Members whose Local Association is Middlesex are eligible for the Stepladder Final which will determine the Male and Female Area Champion.
- Closing date for entries is Sunday 24th May, Entry Fees may be paid in advance or cash on the day.**
 A place in the tournament may be reserved by emailing the relevant details to the Tournament Manager, but the entries MUST be received before the closing date.
- Handicap will be based on 90% of 230 and will be based on a recreational league average of at least 12 games or your average from previous BTBA Tour events in 2019. Proof of entering average must be provided at registration. The maximum handicap for an individual bowler will be 90.**
- The Tournament Manager reserves the right to reject any entry and re-assess any entered average & to disqualify any individual who deliberately submits a false average, subject to an appeal to the BTBA.
- The tournament format is to play 6 games in two blocks of 3 - with a lane dressing between blocks. Bowlers will move lanes after every game. Only the top 5 game scores will be counted.
The Singles Tournament, including Prize Money payout, will be determined on Handicap Scores. Qualification for the Area Championship Stepladder will be determined on Scratch Scores.
- In the event of a tie during the Handicap Singles: the higher placing will be given to the bowler with the highest single game. Then the 2nd highest. If still tied, then any prize money will be shared.
- In the event of a tie on Scratch Totals and qualification for the Stepladder Finals, the higher placing will be given to the bowler with the highest single game. Then the 2nd highest, then 3rd, then 4th. If still tied, then Stepladder placings will be determined by a coin toss.
- A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately.
- Protests must be made within 30 minutes of any infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 72 hours to the Tournament Manager.
- The wearing of denim jeans, combat style clothing or vests is not permitted.
- This is a non-smoking event and no alcohol is allowed during the competition.
- The Entry Fee will be £30 per bowler**
 £19.00 Lineage Fee
 £2.50 Expenses, including a £2 BTBA Tournament Sanction Fee per bowler
 £8.50 contribution to the Prize Fund (which will be returned 100% in Tournament Prizes)

 Upon registration, teams will be given a code number via a random draw. This will determine their lanes.

Free Fall and String averages are both acceptable without differentiation for all handicap tournaments
