## NOTE

**BOWLERS WILL BE ENTERED INTO THE AGE GROUP THEY QUALIFY IN EG: UNDER 22 WILL BE PUT INTO THE UNDER 22 AGE GROUP, UNDER 16 IN UNDER 16 GROUP ETC**

**ALTHOUGH THERE IS NO LONGER A U12 SECTION YORKSHIRE WILL STILL BE PUTTING ON TRAINING AND AN EVENT LATER ON IN THE YEAR.**

**THE SQUADS ARE MADE UP OF 15 MALES AND 15 FEMALES, TOP 10 ARE AUTOMATICALLY SELECTED FOR THE SQUAD AND THERE WILL BE 5 WILD CARD PICKS PER SQUAD SELECTED BY THE SELECTION COMMITTEE**

**THE SELECTION COMMITTEE WILL THEN ALSO DECIDE TO PUT BOWLERS INTO DIFFERENT AGE SQUADS AS REQUIRED.**

## Tournament Format

Competitors will bowl six games changing lanes every 2 games. Odd lanes move 2 pair to the left, even lanes move 2 pair to the right

**Example: 1,9,5—2,6,10** (subject to squad entry size)

The Conditioning pattern will be chosen by the tournament committee prior to the event

Competitors will be notified about the pattern on the day of your squad. As this is a trials the YTBA Committee request that competitors **DO NOT** practice on it

**Games will be bowled scratch**

**All score sheets must be fully completed and be neatly scored with full names etc**

## Registration & Squad Times

Registration time is 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time.

If you are running late for any reason please inform the tournament managers as soon as possible.

## Tournament Committee

The tournament management will comprise of Lee Metcalfe & Mike Cummings or an appointed person. The tournament committee reserves the right to reject any entry and to decide upon any point not covered in these rules. The tournament committee's decision shall be final, subject to an appeal to the BTBA. Protests must be lodged with a tournament manager within 30 minutes of any infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 60 minutes of the end of the game in question.

## General Tournament Rules

The tournament will be sanctioned by the BTBA and run under the current BTBA general playing and tournament rules. Only tournament officials, competitors and one licensed instructor/coach will be allowed in the player's area during bowling. In accordance with BTBA Rule 330, Coaches and instructors are required to display their license at all times and be dressed in accordance to their position.

Bowlers will be required to **sign the county code of conduct** for the 2022 year at the trials to be able to be considered for selection.

## Dress Code

Participants must wear clothing acceptable for public appearances that do not cause offence. The wearing of jeans of any colour, denim shirts or singlet vests will not be permitted. Tailored shorts & Skorts are allowed.

## Eligibility

The bowler must be a current member in good standing with the BTBA or Affiliated Association.

The bowler must meet the relevant eligibility criteria also listed in the inter-county rules. These are available for download from the BTBA website. Juniors who wish to be accepted by the selection committee to be put into squads other than there official age bracket qualifying squad must hold a minimum of a standard BTBA membership.

All geographical County Boundaries will be those as established in 1961.

## Photography Policy

Please be aware before, during, and after the event there could be filming, action photography or video taken of participants by anyone attending the event, either as an official, spectator, parent or guardian.

If you (as a participant, parent or guardian) object to this, you must make your objections known to the tournament committee prior to the squad in question starting and reasonable adjustments will be made."
