# TOURNAMENT RULES

- The Tournament will be sanctioned by the BTBA and the BTBA's General Playing and Tournament Rules will govern this event.
- Entrants MUST% be members of the BTBA and Membership will be checked on the BTBA database (which is available at btba.org.uk).
- A player may be eligible under the following criteria: they were born in Middlesex, they have been resident in Middlesex for at least the last year or they are an Orphan\* Bowler who currently bowls in a Sanctioned League within Middlesex.  
\* An Orphan Bowler is one with no accepted County Association in their county of Birth or Residence.
- A provisional ball will be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. Protests must be lodged verbally with the Tournament Manager at the time of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 72 hours.
- The Tournament Manager will be Wayne Lester and his decision on all matters shall be final, subject to appeal to the BTBA.
- No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcoholic beverages during play or lane change times. Any bowler whose conduct is deemed as derogatory to the best interest of the sport on and off the lanes, during the entire period of the tournament, may be disqualified from the tournament and reported to the BTBA.
- Whilst bowling in the tournament, competitors must be properly and appropriately dressed for bowling. Denim Jeans, shorts (men) are not allowed. Ladies Skirts & Skorts must be longer than the player's fingertips with their arms by their sides (aka the Jo Cundy Rule).
- Adult and Senior County Trials are Scratch events. There is no Handicap nor Age Bonus. Up to 15 players may be selected for each County Squad. In the event of a tie for the final place, the bowler with the highest last game will be awarded that place. If still tied, the player with the highest penultimate game will be selected and so on until the place is determined.
- All entrants must bowl, in order to determine the top 2 qualifiers in each division - who are guaranteed a place in the team for the Inter-Counties Qualifying Round (and will play a minimum of 2 games).
- All Competitors must register at least 30 minutes prior to the squad time. Latecomers will commence scoring at the frame in progress, as determined by the Tournament Manager. On the entry form, entrant's signature is required for the declaration of eligibility.

## Entry Fee

**Entry Fee will be £30 per person for new Trialists, but a reduced fee of £18.50 for 2020 Trialists.**  
This fee will cover lineage (£19.80), Sanction Fee (£2) and Middlesex Expenses.
