Qualifying (Saturday all day & Sunday morning)

6 games, at doubles pace, moving lanes every 3 games.

Squad A bowls between 9-00am & 11-30am on Saturday.

Squad B bowls between 12-15pm & 2-45pm on Saturday.

Squad C bowls between 3-30pm & 6pm on Saturday.

Squad D bowls between 8-30am & 11am on Sunday.

Registration is 30 minutes prior to roll off time.

Space for 80 bowlers in total, 20 per squad.

These (scratch) scores will class as qualification scores for tour rankings.

Finals (Sunday) -registration at 11-30am.

Lane redress

Group stage (between 12pm & 1pm) – Top 10 bowlers ranked based on pin fall from qualifying, will automatically receive a bye for the group stage and qualify for the Scramble.

Next 20 bowlers ranked 11-30 based on pin fall, qualify for the group stage.

They will separate into 5 x groups of 4 as follows;

Group A bowlers ranked 11, 20, 21 & 30.

Group B bowlers ranked 12, 19, 22 & 29.

Group C bowlers ranked 13, 18, 23 & 28.

Group D bowlers ranked 14, 17, 24 & 27.

Group E bowlers ranked 15, 16, 25 & 26.

Each group will then proceed to bowl 2 x games against the other bowlers in their group.

Top 2 bowlers in each group based on the 2 x game pin fall will proceed through to the scramble round.

In the event of a tie, the bowler with the highest low game will proceed.

Scramble (between 1-30pm & 3pm) – Bowlers ranked 1st – 10th from qualifying & 10 bowlers qualifying from the group stage will be placed in 5 x groups of 4 as follows;

Group 1 – Bowler ranked 1st / bowler ranked 10th / winner group A / runner up group E
Group 2 – Bowler ranked 2nd / bowler ranked 9th / winner group B / runner up group D
Group 3 – Bowler ranked 3rd / bowler ranked 8th / winner group C / runner up group C
Group 4 – Bowler ranked 4th / bowler ranked 7th / winner group D / runner up group B
Group 5 – Bowler ranked 5th / bowler ranked 6th / winner group E / runner up group A

Each group will then bowl 2 x games and lose the lowest scoring bowler. In the event of a tie the bowler with the highest low game will proceed.

Remaining bowlers will then continue to bowl and lose the lowest scoring bowler each game until only 1 x bowler remains in each group. In the event of a tie the bowler with the highest low game in the scramble will proceed.

The 5 x remaining bowlers will qualify for the Stepladder Final.

Lane redress.

Stepladder Final (3-30pm & 5pm) – 5 x qualifying bowlers from the scramble will bowl. Positions for the stepladder will be based on the 5 x qualifying bowlers, 4 x game total over the Scramble. In the event of a tie, the bowler with the highest low game will take the higher position.

Bowler 5 Vs Bowler 4, winner vs Bowler 3 & winner vs Bowler 2, winner vs bowler 1.

In the event of a tie, there will be a 1 frame roll off.

Presentation at 5-15pm.

PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

Before, during, and after the event there could be photography, filming or video taken of participants and medal winners by anyone attending the event, either as an official, spectator, parent or guardian.

If you (as a participant, parent or guardian) object to this, you must make your objections known to the tournament manager prior to the event starting and reasonable adjustments will be made."

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This is a YBE tour event and will be sanctioned by the B.T.B.A. their rules will govern the event along with the following special rules and conditions.
2. The tournament is open to bowlers who are 21 years old or younger on the 31st December 2022.
3. All bowlers shall be current members of the BTBA. Membership dates will be checked online by tournament management. If a bowler's membership has expired the bowler can renew online or they may be unable to bowl.
4. This will be a handicap tournament throughout with bowler's handicap being calculated on 85% of 230.
5. Entrants must declare their highest average in any league, tournament or ranking table over 21 games on the day of bowling. Y.B.C. officials/bowlers must submit a current league standing sheet 14 days prior to bowling.
6. The tournament managers are Mike Cummings & Lee Metcalfe.
7. The tournament managers reserve the right to refuse or rerate any entry if they consider there is just cause to do so. Protests must be lodged by the Y.B.C. official / bowler within 30mins.
8. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pin fall cannot be resolved immediately. The tournament manager's decision is final subject to appeal to the B.T.B.A.
9. No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcohol anywhere in the centre during the tournament. Any breach of this rule will result in immediate disqualification of the individual concerned.
10. Profane Language, improper gestures or abuse of bowling equipment / machinery may also result in disqualification
11. Any disqualification may result in loss of scores / awards. Any bowler whose conduct is likely to bring the sport into disrepute will also be disqualified. Any individual disqualified will be reported to the B.T.B.A. for consideration of disciplinary proceedings.
12. Competitors who are not dressed in correct bowling attire in the bowler's area will not be permitted to bowl. Shirts should contain YBC / bowlers name. Denim of any colour will not be permitted.
13. Mobile phones should be turned off and not used in the bowling area.
14. Only tournament officials, bowlers and licensed coaches/YBC officials will be allowed in the playing area.
