LONDON TPBA ICC SELECTION TOURNAMENT 2022

The above trials will take place on: 2nd & 3rd April 2022. Registration will take place 30 minutes before the squad time.

This tournament will have a moral sanction by the BTBA and the general playing and tournament rules together with the following will govern this tournament, together with the following special rules:

Membership

The tournament is open to current members of the BTBA. All memberships will be checked online. If electronic membership can not be proved payment of the current annual membership of £20 (Junior) or £25 (Adult) will be required to participate.

Eligibility

Eligibility for the London TPBA team is dependent on the ICC Tournament rules and available from: <https://btba.org.uk/wp-content/uploads/2018/12/ICC-Rules-Regulations-2019-v1.pdf>

It is your responsibility to check that you are eligible for the London Team. Please ensure that you tick the required box on your entry form.

Bowlers wishing to change county must give 1 years notice in writing to inter-county secretary, or after 1 year in which their names have not been registered with any county, their previous qualification will be deemed to have lapsed and they are at liberty to register for their new county provided they meet the eligibility criteria.

Format

Junior U16 Bowlers will bowl 3 games without changing lanes

U22/Adult/Senior Bowlers will bowl 5 games with changing lanes after each game

Juniors Only

Bowlers born in the year 2000 or later are eligible to play in the U22 Category

Bowlers born in the year 2006 or later are eligible to play in the U16 Category

There MUST be a minimum of 5 entries in the U22 & U16 age category for the selection tournament to proceed

The under 16 team will be mixed (Boys and Girls in the same team).

Seniors Only

Bowlers born in the year 1972 or earlier are eligible to play in the Senior Category

Senior participants must be aged 50 or over on or before the 31st December 2022

Dress Code

Dress code prohibits the wearing of denim jeans, denim skirts or singlet vests.

Disputes

A provisional ball will be rolled if a dispute relating to pin fall or foul cannot be resolved immediately. Protests must be made verbally within 30 minutes of occurrence and confirmed in writing within 72 hours. The tournament manager will be Neil Taylor and his decision will be final, subject to an appeal to the BTBA.

Selection

Selection for the teams will be as follows:

The association will register up to 15 bowlers per team category.

Only bowlers finishing in the Top 2 places in each section will be guaranteed 2 games in the qualifying round.

All team categories will be played scratch; there will be no age bonus in the senior sections.

Only competitors participating in the trials will be considered for the London teams.

Squad Selection

Top 4 bowlers in each section rolling the highest scratch series will be automatically selected along with the captain's pick of bowlers from remaining bowlers in that section. Dispensation can be given for any team England squad member. As per: ICC Tournament Rules.

Team captain/manager; will be elected by the top 4 bowlers in that section after the trials and allocated by the London committee for junior teams.

Please ensure that you are available to bowl on these weekends

Seniors: Qual's: 11th/12th June Finals: 8th/9th Oct

Adults: Qual's: 3rd/4th Sept Finals: 5th/6th Nov

U22's: TBC

U16's: TBC

Entry fee

U16 £25.00; U22, Adults or Seniors £35.00. This includes £2 sanctioning fee.

U22/Adult/Senior bowlers who are eligible for more than one Adult team may have their scores considered on payment of a further £15.00 per event.

U16/U22 bowlers who are eligible for more than one junior team may have their scores considered on payment of a further £10.00 per event

Entry Fees are not refundable after squad has been accepted.

2020 bowlers

If you entered the 2020 selection tournament, the entry fees are:

U22/Adult/Senior bowlers are required to pay £17.50 covering lineage, £2 sanctioning and admin.

Juniors are required to pay £10.

Bank transfers are the preferred payment **Bank details on request**. Please ensure that you notify london@btba.org.uk when making the transfer and also include your name as the reference.

Filming & Photography

Before, during, and after the event there could be photography, filming or video taken of participants and medal winners by anyone attending the event, either as an official, spectator, parent or guardian. If you (as a participant, parent or guardian) object to this, you must make your objections known to the tournament manager prior to the event starting and reasonable adjustments will be made.

All Bowlers participating in the 2022 selection tournament will also be eligible to represent the London area at other challenge events such as the South East challenge and Peterborough challenge.
